

NOTICE OF ORDER

WILDLIFE AND COUNTRYSIDE ACT 1981

The Essex County Council Definitive Map Modification No. 635 (Footpath 19
Mayland, Maldon District) Order 2017

Notice is hereby given that the above referenced Order has been submitted to the Secretary of State for Environment, Food and Rural Affairs for determination. Following an earlier inquiry, the Inspector appointed to determine the Order issued a letter in which she proposed to make modifications to the Order as drafted. Following advertisement of those proposals objections/representations have been received.

The **start date** for the above Order is 5 December 2019

Consideration of the Order will take the form of exchanges of statements of case and comments on statements of case which contain evidence in respect of the Inspector's proposed modifications only.

The effect of the Order, if confirmed without modifications, will be to modify the Definitive Map for the area by:

1. Adding a footpath to be known as footpath 19 Mayland, running from the northern end of North Drive, Mayland, northwards and north-eastwards along Sea View Parade for approximately 91m with a width of 3.1m, then south-eastwards with a width of 4m for approximately 105m. The path then turns eastwards and almost immediately south-eastwards and continues with a width of 2m for a distance of approximately 160m before turning north-eastwards to meet Nipsells Chase.

The effect of the proposed modifications would be to provide for the following:

In the Order schedule: Part I

- Delete the words "then turning south eastwards on the south western side of the boundary with a width of 4m before crossing to the north eastern side of the boundary (B-C on the Order plan), continuing easterly then north eastwards, with a width of 2m to exit onto Nipsells Chase (C-D on the Order plan)"

In the Order schedule: Part II

- Delete the words "then south eastwards with a width of 4m. Turns eastwards then almost immediately south eastwards with a width of 2m and continues easterly before turning north eastwards to meet Nipsells Chase"

On the Order map

- In the key, delete reference to "A-B-C-D" and substitute "A-B".

- Amend the line of the footpath to be added to remove the section B-C-D as shown.

Timetable for sending in statements of case and comments

Within 8 weeks of the start date [by 30 January 2020]

The Order Making Authority, the applicant and everyone who has made an objection or representation following the proposed modification(s) or any other written representation must ensure their statement of case is received by the Secretary of State. As soon as possible after receiving it the Secretary of State will send a full copy to the Authority. Copies (excluding copies of any supporting documents - these will be available to view at the Authority's offices) will also be sent to everyone who has made an objection or representation following the proposed modification(s), the applicant and any other person who has previously written to us in respect of the Order.

Within 14 weeks of the start date [by 12 March 2020]

Everyone who has made an objection or representation following the proposed modification(s), the Authority, the applicant (if applicable) and anyone who has written to us in respect of the Order must ensure their comments on any or every other statement of case is received by the Secretary of State. As soon as possible after the above date, the Secretary of State will send copies of the comments received to everyone else.

Any other person wishing to make representations in writing to the Secretary of State in respect of the above Order must do so in line with the timetable set out above.

In fairness to the other parties everyone should keep to the timetable to ensure that statements of case and comments are received on time.

All parties must keep to the timetable set out above and ensure that statements of case are received by the Secretary of State on time. Late documents will be returned.
