# JUDGMENT

The decision of the Employment Tribunal Judge is that the Claimant's claims succeed and:-

1. The Respondent is ordered to pay the Claimant £1,499.68 (gross) in respect of unlawful deductions made from her wages.
2. The Respondent is ordered to pay the Claimant £908.76 (gross) in respect of holiday pay due to the Claimant on the termination of her employment.
3. The Respondent is ordered to pay the Claimant £150.00 (net) in respect of breach of contract.
