JUDGMENT

- 1. The Claimant's claims succeed. The Respondent shall pay the Claimant as follows:
 - 1.1. Holiday pay £461.54 gross, taxable in the hands of the Claimant;
 - 1.2. Wages £1,153.84 gross, taxable in the hands of the Claimant;
 - 1.3. Notice pay **£25,000** gross, taxable in the hands of the Claimant, (the statutory cap having been applied) and
 - 1.4. Compensation for unfair dismissal, (the Claimant having already received the basic award in the form of a redundancy payment from the Insolvency Service) **£14,570.76**.
- 2. For the avoidance of doubt, the total payable by the Respondent to the Claimant, without deduction, is **£41,186.14**.
- 3. The recoupment provisions do not apply.
