JUDGMENT

Employment Tribunals Rules of Procedure 2013 – Rule 37

The claim is struck out in part, namely the claim of unfair dismissal. All other claims are unaffected by this Judgment.

REASONS

1. By a letter dated 9 July 2019 the Tribunal gave the Claimant an opportunity to make representations or to request a hearing, as to why part of the Claim, namely the claim for unfair dismissal should not be struck out because:
 - it has no reasonable prospect of success because the Claimant has less than 2 years' service.
2. The Claimant has failed to make representations in writing, or has failed to make any sufficient representations, why this should not be done or to request a hearing. That part of the Claim is therefore struck out.
3. The remaining claims brought by the Claimant remain unaffected.
