JUDGMENT

The judgment of the Tribunal is as follows.

- (1) The claim for a payment in respect of holiday pay accrued but untaken on the effective date of termination is not well founded and is dismissed.

- (2) The respondent's application for expenses of £1,200 is refused. The claim has neither been brought nor conducted vexatiously or unreasonably. While the claim had no reasonable prospect of success, as a matter of discretion I decline to award expenses because it would not be just to do so.
