JUDGMENT

- 1. The Claimant was unfairly dismissed.
- 2. It is just and equitable to reduce the compensatory award for unfair dismissal by 100%.
- 3. It is just and equitable to reduce the basic award for unfair dismissal by 75%.
- 4. The respondent shall pay to the claimant a basic award of £1,524.00.
- 5. By consent it is found that the respondent made unauthorized deductions from the claimant's wages, being holiday pay, in the sum of £216.67 gross.
