JUDGMENT

1. The claim of breach of contract for notice pay under s. 3 of the Employment Tribunals Extension of Jurisdiction (England & Wales) Order 1994 is dismissed. The claim was not presented within the relevant statutory time limit and it was reasonably practicable for it to have been.
2. The Claim for accrued but untaken holiday pay under reg. 14 and reg. 30 of the Working Time Regulations 1998 is dismissed.
3. The Claimant succeeds in her claim for a redundancy payment and the Respondent is ordered to pay her the sum of £7,874.
4. The Claimant's claim that there had been an unauthorised I deduction from her wages is well founded and the Respondent is ordered to pay the sum of £7,846.15 gross.
