JUDGMENT

- 1. The Respondent did not discriminate against the Claimant directly or indirectly by dismissing him.
- 2. The complaint of unfair dismissal is not well-founded. This means the Claimant was fairly dismissed. The wrongful dismissal claim also fails.
- 3. The Respondent's counterclaim succeeds and the Claimant shall pay to the Respondent the sum of £317.81.
