Release of Information

Thank you for your correspondence of 19 September 2019 in which you requested the following information:

'If a Royal Marines Young Officer fails, or is unable to take, Commando Tests because of injury and is unsuccessful at, or unable to take, a re-run of any failed Commando Tests is that Young Officer required to first re-take the entire three-week Exercise Crash Action which immediately precedes YO Commando Tests even if the Young Officer successfully completed Exercise Crash Action?

Your enquiry has been considered to be a request for information in accordance with the Freedom of Information Act 2000.

A search for the information has been completed within the Ministry of Defence and I can confirm that information in scope of your request is held. In response to your request, I can confirm that, if an individual fails their Commando Tests, in accordance with the standards laid down in Unit Orders, they are required to re-take EXERCISE CRASH ACTION before they re-attempt the Commando Tests.
