

The Environment Agency is proposing to revoke (cancel) licence number 15/49/272/S/021, held by Mr J Bell and Mrs R Budd trading as Mellingey Smokerie & Trout Farm.

The Environment Agency is required to give notice of this proposal. The Environment Agency give this notice in line with section 52 of the Water Resources Act 1991 (as amended by section 22 of the Water Act 2003) and regulation 31 of the Water Resources (Abstraction and Impounding) Regulations 2006.

This licence allows the licence holder

to abstract a total of 4,544 cubic metres (m³) of water a day, and a total of 315,360 m³ a year, from the Mellingey Stream in St Issey, North Cornwall. This is at National Grid Reference (NGR) SW 9231 7146. The licence holder can abstract water for fish farming.

The proposal is to revoke the licence.

The Environment Agency has made this proposal as part of a programme to help restore sustainable abstraction.
