FREEDOM OF INFORMATION ACT 2000 REQUEST REF: FOI 0748-19

Thank you for your email of 8th August 2019 asking for information under the Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) 2000. You asked:

Can I have the Org chart of the FCO services, Including name and job titles?

This is only for Directors and Deputy Directors. Can I also have there role and responsibilities.

I can confirm that FCO Services does hold information relevant to your request.

The [FCO Services](#) website provides an [Organisation Chart](#) detailing the roles and responsibilities of each of the Directors. Names of current role holders are published annually in our [Annual Reports](#).

FCO Services does have a limited number of Deputy Directors, their names are personal data and withheld under section 40 (2) and 40 (3) of the Freedom of Information Act. The Act states that the processing of personal data should be fair and lawful. It is the fairness aspect which would be breached by disclosure, so there is no public interest test to apply.

Once an FOI request is answered, it is considered to be in the public domain. To promote transparency, we may now publish the response and any material released on [GOV.UK](#) in the [FOI releases](#) section. All personal information in the letter will be removed before publishing.

The information supplied to you continues to be protected by the Copyright, Designs and Patents Act 1988. You are free to use it for your own purposes, including any non-commercial research you are doing and for the purposes of news reporting. Any other re-use, for example commercial publication, would require the permission of the copyright holder. Most documents supplied by the FCO will have been produced by government officials and will be protected by Crown Copyright.
