JUDGMENT

Employment Tribunals Rules of Procedure 2013 – Rule 21

1. In the absence of an ET3 response, and there being sufficient material before me to enable a proper determination to be made, I uphold the following claims **against Ye Olde Cross Keys Inn Limited**:

a. Unpaid Wages:	£387.59
b. Holiday Pay:	£207.50
c. Redundancy Pay:	£250.56
d. Total:	£845.65

2. The claimant is responsible for any income tax or employee national insurance contributions that may be due on the sums awarded in respect of unpaid wages and unpaid holiday pay.

3. I act in accordance with my powers under Rule 21 of the Employment Tribunal's Rules of Procedure 2013.

4. **The claims against Mr John Thompson are dismissed.**
