The committee considered:

- a) Upcoming Parliamentary legislation, focusing particularly on outlining key upcoming legislation, including the Census Bill and the Domestic Abuse Bill.
- b) A factual briefing on the upcoming Domestic Abuse Bill from both The Parliamentary Under Secretary for Safeguarding and Vulnerability and The Parliamentary Under Secretary of State at the Ministry of Justice.
- c) An oral briefing on the statutory Instrument due to be laid shortly relating to Universal Credit from the Minister for Employment.
- d) A factual progress update on confidence and supply.
