A copy of this document, a copy of the Part I of the ITAHC and a completed copy of Part II of the ITAHC must be delivered, faxed or emailed on the same day on which the ITAHC is signed to Centre for International Trade – Carlisle (CITC).
2. In the case of an export not proceeding, this form must be returned to CITC with the unused ITAHC.
3. If the consignment is cancelled, the exporter must advise CITC.
4. If the departure date/time changes or a different vehicle is used, the exporter must advise CITC so that a replacement TRACES message can be sent.
5. An animal could be deemed 'not eligible to travel' due to not fulfilling the health criteria required for Intra-Union trade or due to not being fit to be transported.

1. In the event that the export consignment is selected to undergo an APHA supervised loading, please provide this document to the APHA staff during the supervised loading inspection.
