Thank you for your email of 28 May requesting the following information:

“I would like to have electronic copy of latest explosive regulations or AP 110A-0102-1A”.

I am treating your correspondence as a request for information under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (FOIA).

A search for the information has now been completed within the Ministry of Defence, and I can confirm that all the information in scope of your request is held.

However, the information you have requested falls entirely within the scope of the absolute exemption provided for at Section 21 (Information Reasonably Accessible to the Applicant by Other Means) of the FOIA and has been withheld.

Please note that any request for an internal review must be made within 40 working days of the date on which the attempt to reach informal resolution has come to an end.

If you remain dissatisfied following an internal review, you may take your complaint to the Information Commissioner under the provisions of Section 50 of the Freedom of Information Act. Please note that the Information Commissioner will not normally investigate your case until the MOD internal review process has been completed.
