

NOTICE OF PROPOSAL TO MODIFY DEFINITIVE MAP ORDER

WILDLIFE AND COUNTRYSIDE ACT 1981

Notice is hereby given pursuant to paragraph 8(2) of Schedule 15 to the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981 that the Inspector appointed by the Secretary of State for Environment, Food and Rural Affairs to determine the Kent County Council (Footpath EE487 at Goodnestone) Definitive Map Modification Order 2018 proposes to modify the Order by providing for the following:-

- Delete the sections of the route shown by red hatching on the Order Map and replace them with the sections represented by red dashed lines.
- Amend the key to the Order Map in light of the above modifications.

For location purposes only: the claimed route runs from Thornton Road at NGR TR 2737 5276 north-east for 962 metres to Knowlton Lane at NGR TR 2796 5351. The proposed modification refers to a section midway along the claimed route.

A copy of the Order as submitted and a copy of the Order showing the proposed modification together with the Inspector's Order decision dated 23 December 2019 have been deposited at Kent County Council, PROW & Access Service, Invicta House, County Hall, Maidstone, Kent, ME14 1XX.
