## Within 2 weeks of the start date [by 26 May 2020]

## Within 8 weeks of the start date [by 7 July 2020]

As soon as possible after the deadline, the Secretary of State will send full copies to the Authority. Copies (excluding copies of any supporting documents - these will be available to view at the Authority's offices) will also be sent to the applicant, every person who has made an objection or representation and any other person who has written to us in respect of the Order.

Within the same period the applicant (if applicable) must ensure their statement of case is received by the Secretary of State. As soon as possible after the deadline, Secretary of State will send a full copy to the Authority. Copies will also be sent to everyone who has made an objection or representation and any other person who has written to us in respect of the Order (excluding copies of any supporting documents - these will be available to view at the Authority's offices).

#### Within 14 weeks of the start date [by 18 August 2020]

Everyone who has made an objection or representation, the Authority, the applicant (if applicable) and anyone who has written to us in respect of the Order must ensure that their comments on any or every other statement of case is received by the Secretary of State. As soon as possible after the deadline, the Secretary of State will send copies of these comments to everyone else.

- 1. That the right of way referred to in this order which is not shown in the map and statement subsists or is reasonably alleged to subsist over land in the area to which the map relates.
- 2. That the highway referred to in this order and shown on the map and statement as a highway of a particular description ought to be there shown as a highway of a different description

The authority has consulted with every local authority whose area includes the land to which the order relates. The Derbyshire County Council hereby orders that:

- 1. For the purpose of this order the relevant date is 21 February 2018.
