JUDGMENT

1. Mr Dymond was not, at the relevant times, a disabled person within the meaning of section 6(2) of the Equality Act 2010 by reason of his depression, anxiety and low mood.

2. Mr Dymond's claims of discrimination arising from disability and a failure to make adjustments (sections 15, 20 and 21 Equality Act 2010) being, for the avoidance of doubt, the only discrimination claims made by reference to the protected characteristic of disability, are dismissed.
