JUDGMENT

1. The correct name for the Respondent is CPS Office Supplies Limited and the title to the proceedings is amended accordingly.
2. The Respondent's application to strike out the Claimant's claims was refused.
3. The Claimant's complaint of unlawful deduction of wages is well-founded.
4. The Respondent is ordered to pay £231 to the Claimant, subject to the appropriate deductions for tax and National Insurance. This sum consists of:

Car valet deduction	£25
Commission on turnover up to 22 May 2019	£206

5. The Claimant's claim of breach of contract (loss of fully funded car) is successful and the Claimant is awarded damages of £392.

6. The total to be paid by the Respondent to the Claimant is £623, subject to tax and National Insurance as set out in paragraph 3.
7. The Claimant's claim in respect of failure to inform and consult in relation to TUPE is dismissed upon withdrawal.
