We are writing to you because our records show that you are a VAT registered business and you trade with the EU. This means that you will be affected by changes when the UK leaves the EU on 31 October 2019.

Next steps you need to take to get ready for Brexit

You should now have your EORI (Economic Operator Registration and Identification) number that starts with 'GB'. You will need this for importing and exporting when we leave the ED. But there is more that you can do to get your business ready.

You can:

- use the checklist overleaf to start working through the actions and decisions that you need to make now

- go online to find more detailed step by step guides

 information you'll need to give to the person you are selling to, so that they can complete the transaction
