JUDGMENT

The claim is struck out under the provisions of rule 37 of the Rules contained in Schedule 1 of the Employment Tribunals (Constitution and Rules of Procedure) Regulations 2013 on the grounds that the claim has not been actively pursued in terms of rule 37(1)(d).

REASONS

- 1. A final hearing in this claim was set down for 11 June 2019. Neither party appeared on that date. The Tribunal ordered the claimant to stress if she intended, by Order of 29 June 2019, to pursue the claim.
- On 19 July 2019, the Tribunal gave the claimant an opportunity to give written reasons by 26 July 2019 or to request a hearing in order to consider why the claim should not be struck out.

The claimant has failed to give an acceptable reason why such a judgment should not be made or to request a hearing. The Tribunal therefore strikes out the claim.
