Thank you for your email of 13 September 2019 requesting the following information:

*"On 13 May 1974, a ceremony took place at CAD Bramley to record the closure of the Army School of Ammunition there. A brass plaque, embedded into a large stone, itself mounted on a large square concrete plinth was uncovered to commemorate the history of the school. The plaque bore an inscription commemorating the closure of the School at Bramley after fifty two years, and its re-opening as an independent unit within the Central Ammunition Depot at Kineton. This 'monument' which was sited within the administrative area, forms part of the heritage of the ammunition technician trade which for many years regarded Bramley as its home.*

*I would be grateful if you could confirm that this monument is still in place at Bramley Training area and if it is listed on any local authority heritage record. If the monument still resides there, may access granted to view it.*

*If the monument is no longer there, please provide the details of when it was removed and the location of its final resting place"*

I am treating your correspondence as a request for information under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (FOIA).

A search for the information has now been completed within the Ministry of Defence (MOD) and I can confirm that no information in scope of your request is held.

Under Section 16 of the Act (Advice and Assistance) you may find it helpful to note that DIO have searched Bramley Camp and can confirm only 2 plaques remain on site, pictures of these can be found at Annexes A and B.
