We are treating your email as a request for information in accordance with the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (FOIA 2000).

- 5. How many hate crimes per month have been reported to the police?**
- 6. How many hate crimes per month broken by race/ethnic background and nationality have been reported to the police?**
- 7. How many hate crimes per day have been reported to the police?**
- 8. How many hate crimes per day broken by race/ethnic background and nationality have been reported to the police?**
- 9. How many violent crimes per month have been reported to the police?**
- 10. How many violent crimes per month broken by race/ethnic background and nationality have been reported to the police?**
- 11. How many violent crimes per day have been reported to the police?**

12. How many violent crimes per day broken by race/ethnic background and nationality have been reported to the police?”

A search for information has now been completed by the Ministry of Defence Police and I can confirm that we do hold information in scope of your request.

The information requested in questions 1-4 and 9-12 is provided on the attached spreadsheet. Please note that we are only able to provide information held for each month during the period from 16 September 2018 to 16 September 2019 in order to remain within the appropriate limit as described in the Freedom of Information Act.
