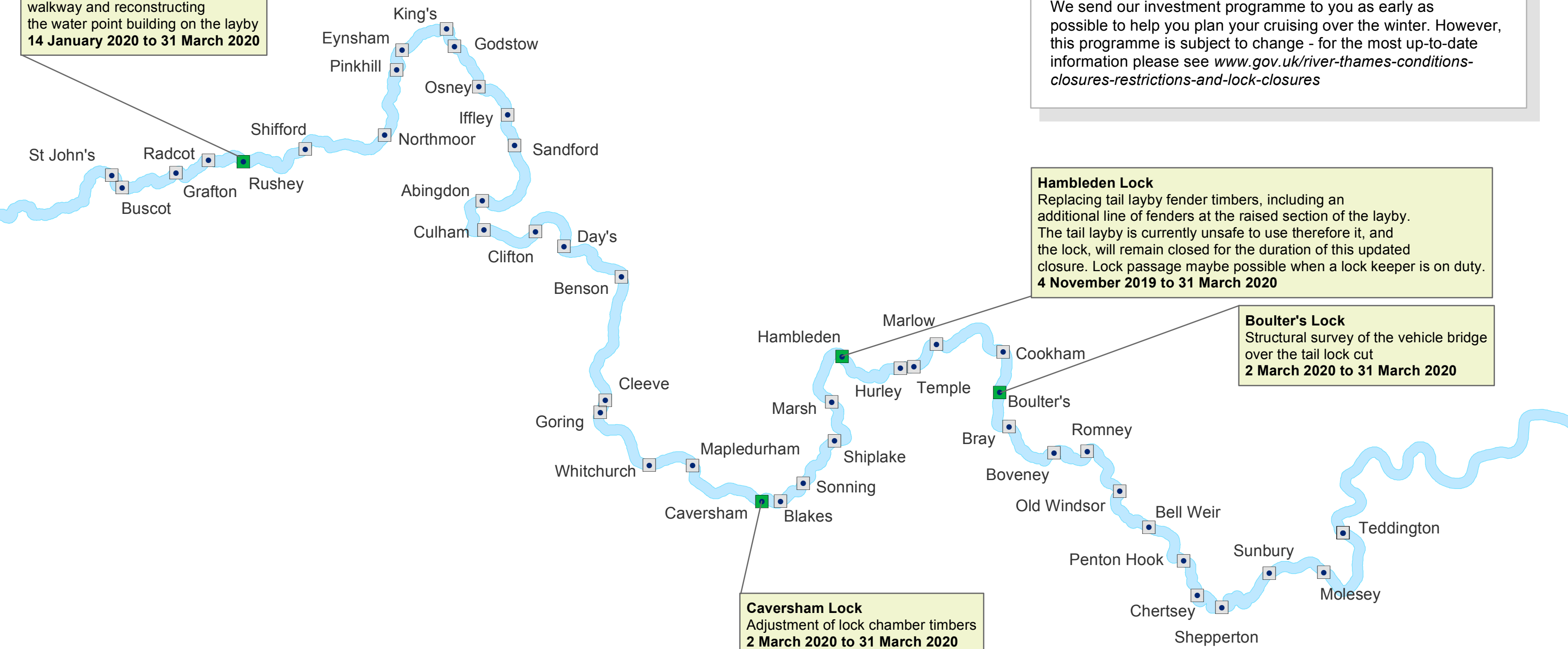
Rushey Lock

The tail layby is currently unsafe to use therefore it, and the lock, will remain closed for the duration of this updated closure. Lock passage maybe possible when a lock keeper is on duty.
