1. Individualised Learner Record R09 2015 to 2016: Closes Friday, 6 May

If you are due to make a return for R09, you must submit your data to the Hub.

2. Advanced Learner Loans: Eligibility Criteria Expanding Information

The eligibility criteria for learners applying for <u>Advanced Leaner Loans</u> will be expanded in the 2016 to 2017 academic year.

Loans will now be available to anyone who has either spent at least half their life or at least 20 years in the UK before the first day of their course.

To access a Loan, learners will also need to demonstrate three years' ordinary lawful residence in the UK immediately preceding the start of their course, and meet other relevant eligibility criteria.
