Individualised Learner Record R10 2015 to 2016: Opens Tuesday, 24 May

The individualised learner record (ILR) R10 data collection for the 2015 to 2016 funding year opens at **9.00am** on **Tuesday**, **24 May**.

The R10 is a mandatory return; you must submit your data to **the Hub**.

We publish a <u>maintenance schedule</u>, which lists collection dates and proposed system maintenance.

2. Skills Funding Service: New Digital Platform

Information

The skills funding service (SFS) is a new digital platform that allows you to view and accept contracts online, without the need to print and return paper contracts. We have successfully processed our first European Social Fund contract using the SFS.

To agree contracts using the SFS, your staff need to <u>register as users</u>. Your superuser can then allocate a contract authoriser role in the role management system. They must do this before we issue your contract.

Shortly, we will contact colleges and other training organisations about when to access this new service to sign other types of contract.
