Announcements, apologies, declarations of interest

19/075 Apologies were noted. There were no declarations of interest raised on matters related to the agenda.

Minutes of the Previous Meeting

19/076 The minutes of the meeting held on 26 September 2019 (enclosure PHE/19/21) were agreed as an accurate record.

Director updates

19/077 The Advisory Board noted that:

a) the PHE Infectious Disease Strategy was now in its implementation phase with SROs appointed for each workstream;

- b) PHE continued to support the NHS on winter planning and delivery of the Long-Term Plan;
- c) PHE had supported the development of the recently published CMO guidelines on physical activity; and
- d) the next evidence review on e-cigarettes would be published in March 2020.

Chief Executive's update

19/078 The Chief Executive advised that:

- a) the recruitments for the London Region Director and Finance and Commercial Director were progressing and announcements would be shared with the Advisory Board in due course; and
- b) he would be attending the International Association of National Public Health Institutes (IANPHI) annual general meeting in early December, which was being held in Addis Ababa.

Finance Report

19/079 The Advisory Board noted that PHE continued to forecast financial break-even at the year-end and full expenditure of the capital programme.

Global Public Health update

- 19/080 Professor Griffiths, Chair of the Global Public Health Committee advised that:
 - a) Advisory Board members had been given a demonstration of the new system which was used to map staff deployments across the world and collate reports from them. There were several benefits, including improved public health intelligence and information sharing, as well as ensuring that PHE fulfilled its duty of care to its staff before, during and after deployment; and
 - b) the UK Rapid Support Team, a joint initiative with the London School of Hygiene and Tropical Medicine, continued to provide ongoing support to the Ebola outbreak in the Democratic Republic of the Congo.
