JUDGMENT

The allegation of direct race discrimination by the Second Respondent on or about 10 October 2018 by not appointing the Claimant as a permanent employee is struck out.

The allegation of direct race discrimination by Amazon on 31 December 2018 by not providing the Claimant with legal and safe checked equipment is struck out.

The allegation of victimisation by Amazon on 31 December 2018 by not providing the Claimant with legal and safe checked equipment is struck out.

REASONS

1. The claimant was ordered to pay a deposit of **£300.00** following a preliminary hearing held on **11th November 2019**. The Order was sent to the claimant on **17th December 2019**. The claimant has failed to pay this deposit. The allegation of direct race discrimination by the Second Respondent on or about 10 October 2018 by not appointing the Claimant as a permanent employee, The allegation of direct race discrimination by Amazon on 31 December 2018 by not providing the Claimant with legal and safe checked equipment and the allegation of victimisation by Amazon on 31 December 2018 by not providing the Claimant with legal and safe checked equipment are therefore struck out under rule 39(4) of the **Employment Tribunals Rules of Procedure 2013**.
