JUDGMENT

- 1. The Claimant's claim that she was unfairly dismissed succeeds; the Respondent shall pay the Claimant compensation in the sum of £922.80.
- 2. The Claimant's complaints of sex discrimination succeed; the Respondent shall pay the Claimant damages in the sum £8,336.
- 3. The Claimant's claim for unpaid wages succeeds; the Respondent shall pay the Claimant £682.50.
- 4. The Claimant's claim in breach of contract, (holiday pay) succeeds; the Respondent shall pay the Claimant £964.92.
- 5. The Claimant's claim of less favourable treatment by reason of being a part time worker fails and is dismissed.

6. For the avoidance of doubt, the total payable by the Respondent to the Claimant under the terms of this Judgment, to be paid without deduction, is £10,906.22.
