## JUDGMENT

It is the Judgment of this Tribunal as follows:

- 1. The claimant's claim for unlawful deduction of wages succeeds and the Tribunal makes a declaration to that effect. In this respect the claimant is awarded £215.28 payable to the claimant by the respondent.
- 2. The claimant's claim for a redundancy payment succeeds. In this respect the Tribunal awards the claimant the sum of £2475 payable by the respondent to the claimant.
- 3. The claimant's claim for breach of contract succeeds and the claimant is awarded the sum of £1995 by way of damages for failure to pay notice. This is payable by the respondent to the claimant.
- 4. The claimant's claim for holiday pay succeeds. The Tribunal awards the claimant the sum of £346.38. This is payable by the respondent to the claimant.
