Unauthorised Deduction from Wages - section 13 Employment Rights Act 1996

- 2. The Claimant was subject to unauthorised deduction from wages as follows:
 - 2.1 2 months' pay for December 2018 (£1,060) and January 2019 (£1,060);
 - 2.2 I month's pay held in arrears (£954).
- 3. The Claimant is awarded £3,074 in compensation. The Respondent is ordered to pay this sum to the Claimant.
