Thank you for your email of 23 October in which you requested the following information:

- 1/ The current total number of Army personnel trained to drive heavy goods vehicles
- 2/ The percentage of that total who are female

I am treating your correspondence as a request for information under the Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) 2000. A search for the information has been completed within the Ministry of Defence and I can confirm that the information in scope of your request is held.

It is not compulsory for individuals to disclose the categories on their driving lincence to the Army. Based on the information that is held (excluding Special Forces) there are 25,974 serving Army personnel who are currently hold Category C and above on their licence. 7% of those personnel are female.
