Booking Data

Booking is defined as: The point at which a pregnant woman first sees a midwife for an antenatal booking history, when details of the current pregnancy are documented in maternity records (which should be an auditable information system but may be a paper-based record where appropriate information systems have not been implemented). The level of reporting is by maternity unit where the woman is booked to deliver (or presents in labour).¹
