JUDGMENT

The Claimant's claim that the Respondent made unlawful deduction from the Claimant's wages is well founded. The Claimant had accrued but untaken holiday entitlement at the time his employment ended of 2.15 days.

- (a) £388.85 for unpaid wages; and
- (b) £116.09 for accrued but untaken holiday.
