JUDGMENT

1. The claimant satisfies the definition of redundancy pursuant to s.139 of the Employment Rights Act 1996, namely the requirements of the respondent's business for employees to carryout work of a particular type have ceased or diminished or are expected to cease or diminish.
2. The respondent is therefore ordered to pay a redundancy payment as the claimant has been dismissed by reason of redundancy pursuant to s.135 of the Employment Rights Act 1996 and the respondent is ordered to pay £8,751.96 redundancy payment.
