- On 13 June 2019, the claimants were dismissed by the respondent by reason of redundancy.
- The respondent did not inform and consult with the claimants in accordance with the provisions of sections 188 and 188A of The Trade Union and Labour Relations (Consolidation) Act 1992 ("the Act").

- The claimants have made claims under section 189 of the Act for a protective award in respect of that failure and the respondent accepts that those claims are well-founded.
- The respondent must make to each of the claimants a protective award in the amount of 8 weeks' pay calculated by reference to that claimant's salary as it stood on 13 June 2019.
- 9 Those protective award payments (i.e. as ordered in paragraph 8 above) will be unsecured claims in the insolvency of the respondent and shall not for the avoidance of doubt be an expense of the administration or payable by the Joint Administrators personally.
- 10 There is and shall be no order as to costs.
