It has a total length of approximately 597 metres as shown between points A-B-C-D on annexed plan numbered 2017/017/DMMO72/A4".
- Insert "TF" in front of the final grid reference in Part II of the Order Schedule.
- Delete the final sentence from Part II of the Order Schedule and insert: "This public footpath has a width of 1.2 metres between OSGR TF10748973 and OSGR TF11069019 and 3 metres between OSGR TF11069019 and OSGR TF11059022. The footpath has a total length of approximately 597 metres".
