JUDGMENT

The unanimous judgment of the Tribunal is:

- 1. The First Respondent and the Second Respondent harassed the claimant, in contravention of the Equality Act 2010:
 - a. by sending her a Facebook message, as alleged, on 12 January 2019;
 and
 - b. by demanding that the claimant work with him, as alleged, on 15 January 2019.
- 2. The First Respondent victimised the Claimant, in contravention of the Equality Act 2010, by:
 - a. subjecting her to a disciplinary process;
 - b. dismissing her; and

- c. issuing her with invoices for childcare fees and threatening her with Court action for non-payment.
- 3. The Claimant's other complaint of harassment and her other complaints of victimisation contrary to the Equality Act 2010 are not made out and are dismissed.
