REMEDY JUDGMENT UNDER RULE 21

- 1. The claimant's claim for unlawful deduction from wages succeeds and the respondent is ordered to pay the claimant workplace pension deductions (made but not accounted for) of £730.03; and
- 2. The claimant's claim for accrued but unpaid holiday pay succeeds and the respondent is ordered to pay the claimant the gross sum of £610.82; and
- 3. The respondent failed to issue the claimant with a written statement of the terms of her employment, and the respondent is ordered to pay the claimant two weeks' pay in the sum of £311.98; and
- 4. The respondent failed to issue the claimant with written pay statements, and the respondent is ordered to pay the claimant two weeks' pay in the sum of £311.98.
