Thank you for your recent email, which was processed under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (FOIA). For clarification, you requested the following information:

*Can you please confirm whether Homes England currently has any contractual agreements with 'Moody's Analytics'? If so, can you please provide detail of:*

- 1. type of services being provided*
- 2. total contract value*
- 3. duration of the agreement (start and end date)*

*Any additional details into the agreement would be greatly appreciated (e.g. the procurement process - was it a tender or call-off).*

**Response**

We can confirm that we do hold the requested information.

The Ministry of Housing, Communities and Local Government (MHCLG) have a subscription to Moody's research, which Homes England took over the payment of in the current period. The subscription provides MHCLG and Homes England with access to up to 400 research documents at a cost of £38,400. The current contract is a 12 month subscription, due to expire at the end of March 2020 and is currently in the process of being renewed. Given the nature of the services it is a Single Tender Procurement.
