Thank you for your email of 28th December, requesting the following information:

“Please can you supply copies of plans for the proposed 1950s bunker into Creechbarrow Hill here for the public to see.”

I am treating your correspondence as a request for information under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (FOIA).

A search for the information has now been completed within the UKHO, and I can confirm that all the information in scope of your request is held. Architectural plans were prepared in 1951 to create a large underground facility on UKHO site, but there is no evidence that this was ever built.

The information you have requested is provided by the UKHO archive.

HO PLANS / 15 Date - 24/7/1951 Scale - 1" to 16'

Please note that any request for an internal review must be made within 40 working days of the date on which the attempt to reach informal resolution has come to an end.

If you remain dissatisfied following an internal review, you may take your complaint to the Information Commissioner under the provisions of Section 50 of the Freedom of Information Act. Please note that the Information Commissioner will not investigate your case until the MOD internal
