If eligible you will be issued with a Notice of Eligibility (NOE) enabling you to sit an MCA oral examination.

The NOE is valid for a period of five years. The NOE will advise you how to apply for an appointment for the examination and what you should do once you have taken the examination.

Oral examination passes for each level of certification are valid for three years. The oral examination pass **must** be in date at the time of issue of the Certificate of Competency (CoC).

A series of Training and Certification Guidance Notes, giving further details of requirements is available from the Seafarer Training & Certification Branch, the contact details are below, or they can be found on the MCA website.

1. PERSONAL DETAILS

4. SEA SERVICE

For all applications the sea service declaration (page 2) must be completed in full.

Service should be in the deck department.

Sea service is time spent at sea, at anchor, on river or canal transits and time in port associated with the work on a Workboat.

Watch Keeping Service is sea service spent as a Watch Keeping Officer in full charge of a navigational watch for not less than four out of every 24 hours. Shorter periods may be aggregated together.

Length of Voyage: this must be given in calendar months and days, e.g. from 3 January to 5 March = 2 months and 3 days. Odd days should be added together and reckoned at 30 days to the month. Please specify under voyage the area worked e.g. unlimited area or categorised waters.

For all sea service that is declared, you **must** submit two forms of evidence. One form of evidence can be Discharge Book entries or Certificates of Discharge, and the other form of evidence can be sea service testimonials; testimonials must be countersigned by the Master or an authorised company representative. Testimonials need to state the sign on and sign off dates and watch keeping service undertaken.

Masters should obtain a company letter providing confirmation of their sea service signed by an authorised official within the company. We will not accept self certified sea service.

Sea service requirements:

From Master (Code vessel < 200 GT) to Master Workboats < 500 GT

Complete 36 months sea service on vessels of any size, including not less than 12 months sea service and 120 days watch keeping service in vessels 15 metres or over in load line length, whilst holding a Master (Code vessel 200 GT) CoC. You must have completed 6 months sea service on a workboat of 15m or over in load line length. **Note:** Your 6 months service onboard a workboat can be completed within the 12 months specified above, although this is not mandatory.

From OOW unlimited to Master Workboats < 500 GT

Complete 12 months sea service holding an OOW unlimited CoC, including not less than 120 days watch keeping service in vessels of 15m or over in load line length. You must have completed 6 months sea service on a workboat of 15m or over in load line length.

Note: Your 6 months service onboard a workboat can be completed within the 12 months specified above although, this is not mandatory.

From OOW (Yachts < 3000 GT) to Master Workboats < 500 GT

Complete 12 months sea service since gaining OOW (yachts < 3000 GT) CoC, including not less than 120 days watch keeping service on vessels of 15m or over in load line length. You must have completed 6 months sea service on a workboat of 15m or over in load line length. **Note:** Your 6 months service onboard a workboat can be completed within the 12 months specified above, although this is not mandatory.

From Fishing Class 1 to Master Workboat < 500 GT

Complete 6 months sea service on a workboat of 15m or over in load line length including not less than 120 days watch keeping service in vessels of 15m or over in load line length.



Before a United Kingdom Certificate of Competency can be issued, you will need to submit certain documentation as specified in this section and MGN 496 (M).

Medical Fitness Certificates

All candidates for any CoC ${\it must}$ produce a valid medical fitness certificate, either:

- The UK medical fitness certificate, currently known as an ENG 1, issued by an MCA approved medical practitioner; or
- A certificate issued by the Administration of any country whose medical fitness certificate is recognised as equivalent to the UK ENG 1

Medical Fitness Certificates must be valid at the time of issue of the CoC.

Training Record Book

Training Record Books are assessed by a Deck Examiner, please ensure they are fully completed and are submitted in a presentable manner, failure to do so may result in a delay in your application.

4B/C/D/E – You must submit the documents in these sections before your CoC can be issued. They are not required for the issue of the NOE. If you wish to include the documents at this stage please ensure you tick (✓) the relevant boxes to indicate which documents you have enclosed with this application.

Training Modules

Training module passes for each level of certification are valid for three years with the exception of the workboat module which is valid for five years. The training module pass certificate must be in date at the time of issue of the CoC.

ECDIS

The STCW Convention 1978 has been amended by the 2010 Manila Amendments and contains new requirements for all seafarers. Seafarers applying for a new CoC or revalidating an existing CoC will be required to submit additional evidence to ensure their certificate is valid for service on certain types of ships after 31 December 2016. There is no additional action required for seafarers who do not work on and do not intend to work on ships fitted with ECDIS. These seafarers will receive the following limitation:

"From the 1 January 2017 this certificate is not valid for service on ships fitted with ECDIS."

For new CoC's the above limitation will apply unless you submit one of the following:

- MCA approved ECDIS course completed on or after 01 January 2005; or
- MCA approved NARAS/ NAEST* (Operational Level or Management) course completed on or after 01January 2005
