The completion of this Import Notification Form is the legal responsibility of the Importer (who must be UK-based). CIT will not complete parts of this form on behalf of the Importer.

As set out in the Trade in Animal Related Products (TARP) regulations, you have a legal obligation to notify APHA of consignments of live animals and genetic material you intend to import from the EU. This is done by completing and submitting this Import Notification Form (ensuring the completion of all mandatory fields) at least 24 hours prior to intended consignment arrival into the UK.

You can notify APHA up to 30 days in advance. To minimise the risk of delays in processing, we recommend submitting your notification at least two working days before the consignment is due to arrive in the UK.

Should you need to change your notification after submission, you must update our operational team by email or telephone.
