So, sufficient training is available for anyone operating/managing surveillance camera systems
9.2	Embed information about SC Code and associated guidance and legislation in any training which is made available about video surveillance camera systems.	All training courses are up to date and anyone working with surveillance cameras (installers, operators, managers, security guards and so on) know what training is required and what is available so they can meet legal requirements.	31/10/2020	Will mean that surveillance cameras are more likely to be used within the legal parameters - therefore proportionately, effectively and transparently.
9.3	Development of an easily navigated web-based tool that enables people to quickly understand what their training requirements and where to find that training.	People in the surveillance camera industry can easily find training relevant for their role.	31/12/2020	This will support the operation of surveillance cameras and ensure they are operated correctly and legally.
9.4	Basic e-learning package is developed that sets out legal obligations for organisations using video surveillance camera systems and reference relevant guidance and so on.
