COMPLETED	Closer co-ordination between these regulators will help identify and deliver synergies, and reduce the potential for any regulatory confusion for the system operators, the public and wider stakeholder community.
10.2	Her Majesty's Inspectorate of Constabulary (HMIC) to develop a mechanism to determine forces are paying 'due regard' to the SC Code.	When forces demonstrate that all public space surveillance camera systems (including body worn video, ANPR, CCTV and Drones) have been subject to self assessment process and where possible details are published.	ONGOING	Promotes understanding and importance of SC Code as well as delivering assurance as to statutory (PoFA) compliance. Identifies strengths, weaknesses, good practice and more detailed understanding as to efficacy of SC Code provisions to user community.
10.3	Office of Surveillance Commissioners (OSC) inspections of a public authority's use of covert surveillance is able to draw some reliance upon third party certification of SC Code compliance where para 2.27 Home Office Code of Practice Covert Surveillance and Property Interference has relevance.	Arrangements agreed between SCC and OSC come into effect.	COMPLETED	Greater onus on police forces and local authorities to consider and address the complexities and statutory requirements relevant to overt and covert use of surveillance camera systems in public places.
10.4	Establish MoU or other protocols with other regulators to enable close working in respect of the regulation of surveillance cameras pursuant of paragraph 5.2 SC Code.	Publication of Mou and other protocols.	COMPLETED	Enables closer collaboration with other regulators to raise standards.
10.5	Energise debate and contribution from Government, Home Office and regulators, to deliver relevant and meaningful legal and regulatory guidance concerning the use of technologies integrated with surveillance camera systems.	Guidance is produced and published on the SCC's website.	ONGOING	Informs the public as to the role of a number of regulatory bodies in so far as surveillance is concerned.
