The results for the following specific fields should be identified:

1. Failed to achieve the minimum standard for the Assault Course.
2. Failed 1.5 mile assessment.
3. Failed VO2 max test.
4. Failed to accumulate enough points.
5. Failed to achieve the minimum standard for pull ups.
6. Swim Fail - Deferred Pass.
7. Candidate failed to display confidence at height.
8. Withdrawn by OC on Bottom Field.
9. Withdrawn by OC on Endurance Course.
10. Withdrawn at own request on Bottom Field.
11. Withdrew at own request.
12. Medical Fail.

Your enquiry has been considered to be a request for information in accordance with the Freedom of Information (FOI) Act 2000.

A search for the information has been completed within the Ministry of Defence and I can confirm that information in scope of your request is held. The results for the Potential Royal Marines Course held at Commando Training Centre Royal Marines from 21 January to 24 January 2020 can be found in Annex A to this letter.

Please be advised that the numbers within the table cannot be broken down further as disclosure could risk the identification of individuals which would put the Department in breach of our obligations under the Data Protection Act 2018 when handling personal data. Section 40(2) of the FOI Act applies to personal data relating to third parties and has therefore been applied with smaller numbers suppressed in line with Departmental policy on disclosure.
