"Dear UK Hydrographic Office, I am looking to produce a book about Exmouth docks in its last years as a commercial dock, and are wondering if a plan of the docks exists from the period."

Our Research team, who are based in the UKHO Archive, provided the following response:

We have conducted a search of our relevant survey ledgers to determine whether we have any plans of Exmouth docks submitted during the 1980's. The only document listed for this period is entitled:

Exmouth Harbour and approaches; dated 1987 and submitted by Herrington Geoscience Associates (UKHO document reference M1011).

There is also a file H2798/84 and Admiralty chart 2290. We have provided a low-resolution image of the published chart of River Exe from 2005 which does include the docks. (Please see image on next page.)

Unfortunately, UKHO Research staff are currently working from home due to the COVID-19 pandemic. At present we only have access to existing digital images, and it doesn't appear we have any of chart 2290 that date to the 1980's. We will need to access the paper record copies held within the Archive, which will not be possible for some time.
