JUDGMENT

The respondent's application dated 8 April 2019 for reconsideration of the judgment sent to the parties on 28 March 2019 is refused.

REASONS

1. There is no reasonable prospect of the original decision being varied or revoked, because the Respondent's application for a reconsideration has not been pursued, and has been treated by the Tribunal as withdrawn. By a letter sent to the parties by the Tribunal by email on 7 January 2020, the parties were notified of the Tribunal's decision to grant the Claimant's unopposed application to postpone the hearing fixed for 14 January 2020. The parties were further informed that as it appeared to the Tribunal that the Respondent may have been dissolved, it was to provide confirmation to the Tribunal in writing that the application for a reconsideration was still being pursued, accompanied by confirmation about the Respondent's current corporate status. The Respondent was informed that a failure to provide this information would lead to the Tribunal treating the reconsideration application as withdrawn.
2. No response having been received from the Respondent, the application was treated as withdrawn, and was therefore refused. The Judgment sent to the parties on 28 March 2019 for the reasons dated 30 September 2019 still stand therefore.
