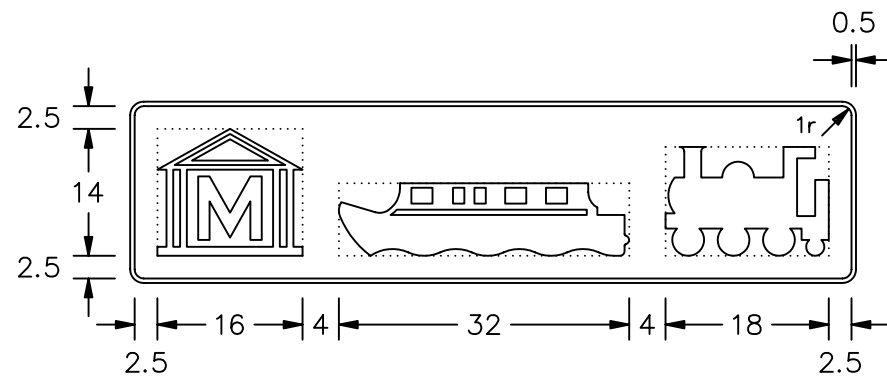
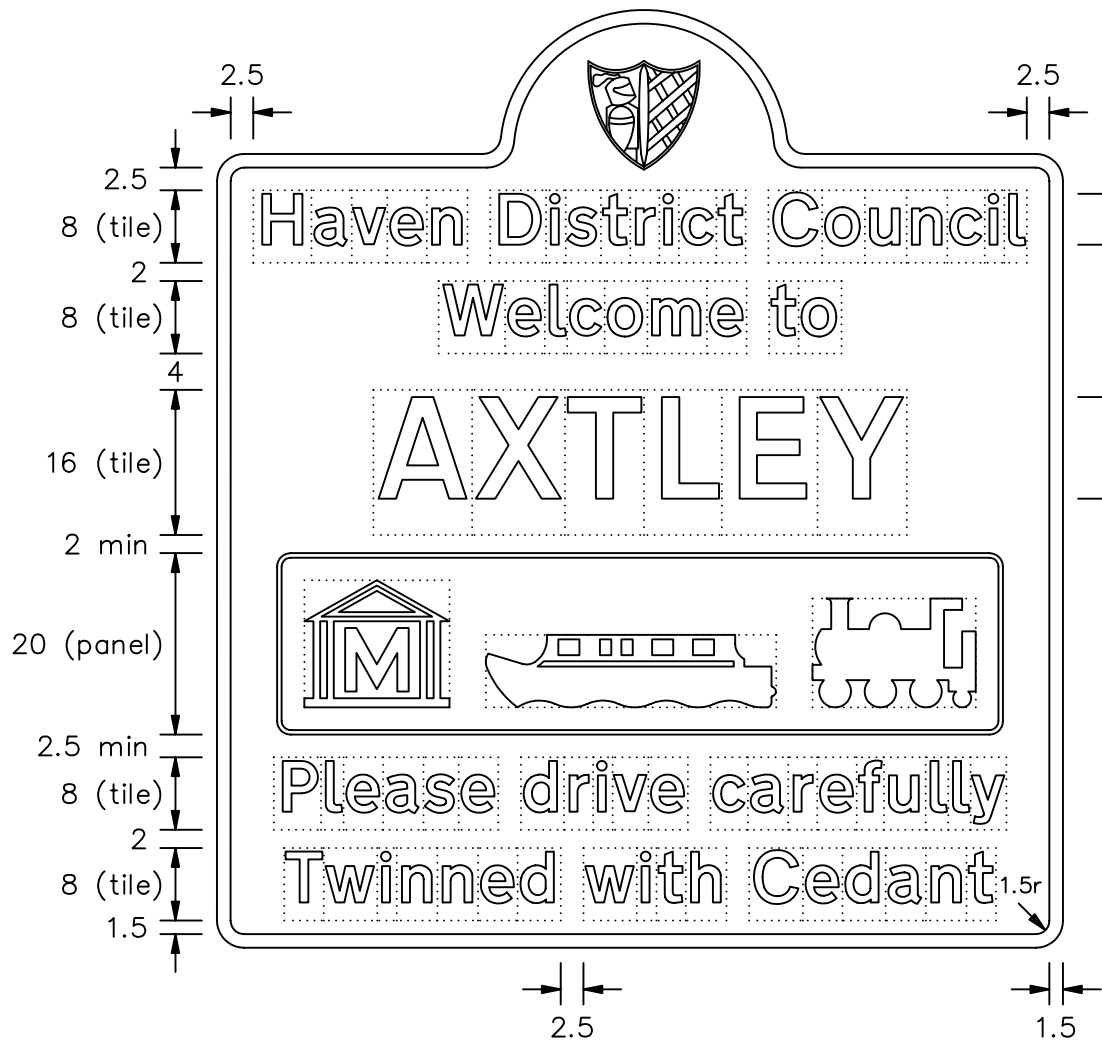

- NOTES:
1. The legend shown is from the Transport Medium alphabet. Other lettering style, with capital letter heights as shown, may be used.
 2. Details of the tourist attraction symbols are given on the 'T' and 'AT' series of drawings.
 3. The tile outlines do not form part of the sign.
 4. COLOURS : Any contrasting colours, except red, may be used. Where Transport Alphabet is used, Transport Medium should be used for light characters on a dark background and Transport Heavy for dark characters on a light background. The tourist attraction panel is always brown with white symbols and border. The border of the panel shall be omitted when placed on a light background.
 5. DIMENSIONS : Letter heights are in millimetres, other dimensions are in stroke widths based on the height of the smaller letters (5.6sw = capital letter height). The smaller legends in the sign illustrated have all be drawn at half the letter size of the place name.
 6. The sign may be varied in accordance with the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2002.
