Variation of consent under section 72(3C) of the Enterprise Act 2002 (the Act)

On 8 June 2020, the Competition and Markets Authority (**CMA**) made derogations to the Initial Enforcement Order of 8 June 2020 (the **Initial Order**) in relation to the completed acquisition by Aragorn Parent Corporation of OverDrive Holdings, Inc. These derogations related to the transfer of OverDrive UK Employees and OverDrive Canada Employees (the '**OverDrive Employees Derogations'**).

After due consideration of your further request contained in an email dated 9 June 2020 for derogations from the Initial Order, based on the information received from you and in the particular circumstances of this case, the CMA hereby varies the OverDrive Employees Derogations pursuant to section 72(3C) of the Act:
